- Does our space provide choice and options with respect to working conditions and location (i.e. quiet spaces for focused work, sound proof spaces for privacy, communal spaces for collaboration).
- Does our firm operations align with client and stakeholder Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) goals / requirements?
